How do you view the Easter Message?

The resurrection is the centre of all Christian belief. The ultimate fear of humankind has always been death. As Christians we believe that the death that could not hold Jesus in the grave will also not hold those of us who believe in Him.

Paul said *"If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins"*. Throughout history many people have tried to disprove the biblical account of the resurrection. They know that if this can be disproved then the Christian religion is meaningless.

There are very strong reasons to support the empty tomb account as true according to the Scriptures.

1. To prove the empty tomb was a lie, all the Jews or Romans had to do was to present the body of Jesus to prove He did not rise from the dead. But they could not do that.
2. If the apostles had stolen the body, they would not have gone about preaching the gospel and suffered agonising deaths for what they knew was a lie.
3. What about the incredible transformation in the lives of those people who accepted Jesus' claims and believed in Him?

To this day, no one has given a more rational answer than that of the scriptures: *"God has raised Him up from the dead!"*

We serve a risen saviour. The creator of the universe has restored His relationship with those who believe in the death and resurrection of Jesus and accept His death as payment for our sins. We can rejoice this Easter that we can be sons and daughters of God and have a hope and a future in Him.
