Taupo LifeKeys Trust Update
Taupo LifeKeys Trust has two main focus areas at present;

- 1) Christians against Poverty (CAP)** which includes tailored help for people who are struggling to live day-to-day because of debt, and Release groups that help people who are struggling with addictive habits and behaviours.
- 2) Provide governance support for Te Haahi**, as they establish a network of national victim support organisations that helps those who have been victims of family harm and it's wider implications. Volunteers are a first response to families referred by local police, where there has been low level trauma in the homes. Their aim is to provide support and practical assistance to these families.

The Trust is also being led into looking more closely at the current housing issues in Taupo, both for the vulnerable and for low income families and . Please continue to pray for the work being undertaken by the Trustees; that The Lord continues to use His church to make a positive difference in Taupo.
