**The Palace Test - Study** (Dream to Destiny Robert Morris)

1. What is the biblical meaning of the words “prosper” and “prosperity”?
2. There is a 'hyper prosperity teaching' around today that is deceptive because it focuses on selfish ambition, rather than on glorifying God and helping others. Have you encountered this? Give some examples.
3. *'Doing the right thing is a life choice that is often rewarded, but not always right away'*. You may have the favour of God yet be falsely accused and end up in prison for 12 years. Discuss.
4. What does Proverbs 28:13 say we are to do when we make mistakes? What will happen if we do not?
5. Sometimes, the higher God wants to take us - the lower we have to go in the natural. You can't build a multi-storeyed building on the foundation of a small house. How has this applied in the lives of people that you know.
6. God only walks with obedient servants. Our attitudes are as important to God as our actions. It's possible to be obedient to His rules and laws, yet unwilling to obey his promptings with a willing heart, that wants to serve and please Him. 2 Chron 16:9. Discuss
7. How did God prosper Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joshua and David?
8. What are practical ways to “hear” the Word of God? What ways have been the most effective or beneficial for you? How can we encourage one another to “increase our intake” of the Word?

9. In what area of your life do you need to hear and obey God?
10. Thank God for His goodness and for wanting to prosper you. Ask Him to reveal areas of unbelief in your heart. Repent of areas of unbelief and disobedience in your life.
11. Pray that the Lord will give you a “heart” to hear and receive the truth of His Word that you may walk with Him daily.
