### Daniel in the Lion's Den (Daniel 6)

1. Find three or four words to describe each of the main characters in this chapter.
2. Daniel clearly reveals the “wisdom from above” (Pure, Peace-loving, Teachable, Transparent, Gentle, Impartial Merciful) His accusers epitomise “the wisdom from below” James 3:14-16. What does this consist of?
3. What was the conclusion of the investigation into Daniel's character by his enemies? Name someone you know who is known for their Godly character.
4. If you were being scrutinised like Daniel was, what aspects of your behaviour would you hide or change?
5. Describe a time when you (or someone you know) have experienced difficulties/persecution directly related to their religious beliefs.
6. What impact did Dan 6: 14-20 have on the King?
7. How did Daniels survival of this ordeal impact his testimony and influence? Share about an incident you have experienced that has strengthened your testimony.
8. What have you learned from Daniel that has encouraged you to be a more Christ-like example to those around you?

9. How bold would you be in standing up for your faith amid persecution? Can you think of some possible future legislation that you would feel uncomfortable about if it was forced upon you?
10. “The most important part of a believer’s life is the part that only God sees”? Discuss. Pray for each other.
