After the first 3 months of a crazy lockdown we were able to start the ministry with lots of new rules, but it was worth doing in spite of extra work; repeating the same class twice, each class/program programs had to be done twice because of social distance. First big test was with grade 5 and 6, running the boys and girls brigade 76 kids, 4 groups ...

but it was a blessing, with Honoria who had been in Brazil for 2 years taking leadership, training, preparing stories, dramas, dance and together with the young people and teachers who run the BB/GB program. They are doing an amazing job teaching the kids about who they are in God.

**Clinics Lebutum**

The clinic continues the work with the normal schedule, being very careful and being the answer for so many people in the mountains that can not afford to come to Dili for a consultation. Lives are being saved and the love of God is being spread.

The mothers and baby programs are growing. Immunisation programs and family planning are some of the other programs running more often now.
