Youth Group and Belonging to a Community

Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching. Hebrews. 10:24-25

COVID may have closed down New Zealand but it has not stopped the youth and the young adults from connecting, but just not in the way we wish.

This time has shown us how important it is for us to connect with each other, not only one-on-one, but as a community. As youth, we have been connecting over Zoom every Wednesday during lockdown. There has been close to 20 of us logging in each time. This has been in part to being challenged by their community and by the youth leaders. They have been pushed on by what has been said at Easter camp ('All In') and Xtend. Some are sharing their faith as leaders at Kids Camp and in Kids Church. I just can't wait to see them serving more at church.

I want to say a big thank you, to you the TBC community, for your prayers, for your investment, for your children that you send to youth and for all your encouragement.
